Summary: The Outreach Intern is responsible for securing and staffing events that promote Race participation, teams and volunteer opportunities. In addition the intern will assist with marketing and distribution of Race collateral.

Summer term (through Race day, Sunday, October 10): Hours are flexible, but may include weekends. Approximately 10-15 hours per week.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Research and identify events to promote the Race
- Work with high traffic businesses, malls, schools, associations to place Race collateral (posters, fliers, etc.)
- Staff events or coordinate volunteers for staffing
- Identify targeted distribution of collateral
- Assist with Pre-Race special event planning
- Work at occasional pre-race fundraising/special events
- Attend monthly Eugene Race for the Cure meetings (second Monday in the evening)
- Other projects as assigned
